## YEARLY MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST



### Spring

- Schedule a routine service appointment with Garrett's
- Check tires, pressure, and tread depth
- Check alignment
- Test your brakes; schedule an adjustment if necessary
- Check steering
- Clean the battery connections with baking soda and water; if you see serious corrosion or can't get your golf cart to start, you may need to replace the battery



#### Summer

- Check tires, pressure, and tread depth
- Check bushings; replace if worn out
- Check for oil leakage
- Check for battery corrosion or destroyed wires
- If you have a gas cart, inspect the engine
- Check steering;
   adjust steering wheel
   if too loose
- Replace spark plugs if necessary (replace every 3 years)
- Replace fuel filters
- Check drive belt; replace immediately if cracked or missing chunks
- Perform basic safety inspection
- Check for loose connections



#### Fall

- Schedule a routine service appointment with Garrett's
- Check tires, pressure, and tread depth
- Check alignment
- Test your brakes; schedule an adjustment if necessary
- Check steering

#### Winter

- If you have a gasoline cart, inspect the engine
- If you have an electric cart, charge the battery completely and clean it with an anti-corrosive before putting it in storage; spray the battery with an acid neutralizer
- Charge your battery
  weekly, even if you're
  not using your cart. Be
  sure to disconnect/
  reconnect the charger
  from the wall each time
  to reset the charger
- Check tires, pressure, and tread depth
- Bring your cart in for an annual tuneup so it will be ready come springtime
- Oconsider upgrading or trading in your golf cart so you will be ready to ride in style in the spring!
